





Blindstamped brown cloth with black decoration to the front board and spine. Minor rubbing and slightly knocked corners but largely clean. There is cracking to the front and rear, and soiling to the untrimmed page edges. Minor foxing to the first and final pages otherwise the contents are in very good clean condition. £75






The decorated red cloth boards are very good but the spine as soiling and is also partially split (10cm approx.) at the rear. There is light to moderate foxing throughout the contents which are otherwise also very good. 44 page publisher catalogue to the rear. £57.50

An early edition in yellow card covers which are bright with light soiling and a faint stamp from Arthur Stebbings. The has loss to both tips and some minor wear to the hinges. Soiling and foxing to the page edges with foxing also to the earlier part of the book. The verso of the title page has some ink and pencil inscriptions including some train times to Lowestoft. The remainder of the contents are very good including a large folding map in the rear pocket which is clean with only minor tears to the creases, and contains another stamp from Arthur Stebbings. £30






An edition in red cloth boards which are bright and clean though with sunning and a little staining to the spine. Soundly bound with clean edges and with slightly cracked front endpapers. Small vignettes have been stuck down to the verso of the preface and the illustration list plus there is a large vignette to the verso of the illustration list. These have left some staining but the remainder of the contents are in fine clean condition. The folding map in the rear pocket is a 'Reduced Map' which has foxing, small tears/wear to the edges plus an old stained tape repair. £30

Gilt decorated Prussian Blue cloth boards with a little wear and fading to the spine but otherwise very good. With clean edges and unmarked endpapers. The endpapers are cracked at the front and rear but the illustrated contents are in very good clean condition. £35





Green cloth boards with gilt decoration are in very good condition with modest staining and a small nick to the bottom of the spine. AEG and with pastedowns unmarked but damaged due to removal of a presumed cover. The contents, illustrated on each page, are in very good condition. Two Frontis vignettes are heavily foxed but the 31 additional tissue guarded plates by Beckwith and Topham are very good with light to modest foxing. A very good soundly bound copy. £50

Rubbed and stained original illustrated brown cloth boards with wear to the edges and corners. Stained and soiled page edges but soundly bound and only a single minor blemish to the endpapers. Photogravure frontis with staining to the upper corners and with all other illustrations amongst the text. There is light tanning to the pages which are very good and clean. The pagination is in error due to the absence of the photogravures found in the deluxe edition. £57.50



Maroon cloth boards with white yacht illustration and gilt lettering. There is minor rubbing and staining plus some fading to the spine which has slight wear to the tips. Soiling to the page edges, glue repairs apparent to the endpapers and with a signature to the half title page. Partially removed signature to the title page also and with light to modest foxing throughout the contents. All plates and plans are present and in very good condition. However there is staining to


the text in the latter part of the book with the final pages including the index notably stained and slightly warped. £29.50






Bright clean turquoise illustrated cloth boards with gilt decoration and lettering. Minor rubbing only but with a repaired tear to the top of the spine. Minor tape staining to the ffeop which is also tanned but well bound with the contents in very good clean condition, as is the rear folding map. £75

The blue illustrated boards are rubbed with a little wear to the tips of the spine and have modest soiling and staining. There is modest soiling to the edges and an inscription dated 1908 to the ffep. The contents are all in very good clean condition. £25

A soundly bound copy but with heavily faded red cloth boards. These are only a little rubbed and knocked but there is also heavy staining to the spine and the untrimmed edges are soiled. 



The red cloth boards with black lettering to front and spine are soiled and stained, more noticeably so to the spine. The corners are slightly knocked and there are single tears to the tips of the spine. The page edges are soiled and there is a small signature to the ffep. The text has some light to moderate foxing but the 31 photographic plates are in fine clean condition. Index and publisher listing to the rear. £12.50






The dust jacket is bright with a colour illustration to the front and has minor soiling only to the spine. There are several chips to the creases & edges and loss to the top of the spine (3cm deep) plus minor loss to the bottom (no more than 1cm deep). There is also a tear and tape stain to the upper left part of the front cover. The book and eight colour plates are in very good clean condition and the map has a tear to one crease but is also torn around the centre. No repairs have been attempted to this. £25



There is an ink inscription to the ffe dated 1945 and the contents including 46 colour plates are in fine clean condition as is the rear folding map. £65










