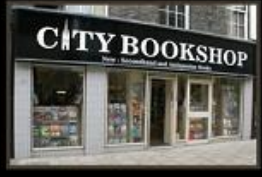

## Antiquarian and Rare

1. **Andrews, William** [Editor]. Bygone Norfolk, 8vo [8],290,[14]pp William Andrews & Co., 1898. HB.

A fine copy. TEG with a little foxing to the edges and the earlier and latter pages. Loosely inserted is an EDP book review of 1898. £45

2. [**Anon.**]. The Poll for a Knight of the Shire for the Eastern Division of the County of Norfolk, Taken on the 29th of June, 1858, with the entire register of the electors, and an account of the position of parties between the contests of 1837 and 1858., 8vo xxxiv,200pp R. N. Bacon, 1858. HB.

Ex-library copy in well rubbed quarter leather binding with title in gilt to the spine. Slightly sunned and worn cloth boards. Foxing to the endpapers (with library labels both present and removed) this has also affected the very first and last pages. Otherwise in fine clean condition. £75

3. **Bartell, Edmund**. Cromer, considered as a Watering Place; with observations on the picturesque scenery in its neighbourhood., 2<sup>nd</sup> Ed. Large 8vo (xii),124,[2]pp J. Taylor, 1806. HB.

Half calf with marbled boards and with raised decorated bands to the spine. Ex libris bookplate of Dorothy Mary Gladstone to the front pastedown. A very nice copy. Edmund Bartell penned the first guide to Cromer in 1800 and this the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition was published in 1806, much expanded and with fine aquatint plates and a hand coloured map. The only other book he wrote was 'Hints for Ornamental Cottages' in 1804. Copies of 'Cromer' are scarce with the 1<sup>st</sup> 1800 edition almost unobtainable. £245

4. **Berlyn, Mrs Alfred**. Sunrise-Land. Rambles in Eastern England., 12mo vi,x,(337),(xix)pp Jarrold & Sons, 1894. HB.

In original pictorial boards with worn corners and soiling to the spine but otherwise bright. Loss to the very tips of the spine. Contents in very good clean condition with some illustrations by Arthur Rackham. £25

5. **Berlyn, Mrs Alfred**. Russell, Walter W [Illus.]. Vera in Poppyland, Large 8vo 70,[2]pp Jarrold and Sons, [1891]. HB.

Recased with few remains of cover laid down. Very scarce. £65

6. **Birkbeck, Geoffrey**. Old Norfolk Houses: Illustrated with thirty-six reproductions in colour, 4to 132pp Jarrold & Sons, [1908]. HB.

Rebacked with old spine laid down. TEG and marbled endpapers. Fine clean internal condition with tissue guarded tipped in plates. Birkbeck was an artist and last owner of Stoke Holy Cross Hall. He subsequently lived in Poringland and was a member of the banking family. £85

7. **Blomefield, Francis.** An Essay towards a Topographical History of the County of Norfolk, containing a description of the Towns, Villages, and Hamlets, with the foundations of Monasteries, Churches, Chapels, Chantries, and other Religious Buildings: [...]. In 11 Volumes, Large 8vo xvi,548,[2]pp &c. William Miller 1805-1810. HB.

An unusually clean and tight set of Blomefield's History of Norfolk in light brown cloth with gilt title on morocco to the spine. All plates present including the usually missing Norwich and Lynn plans. £975

A second set is available in calf binding at £1250

8. **Browne, P.** The History of Norwich, from the Earliest Records to the Present Time., 8vo 437,[1],[10]pp Bacon, Kinnebrook and Co., 1814. HB.

Full calf, rebaked with new spine and worn remainders of the original boards. New endpapers and foxing to part of the contents. Index to rear and with 3 aquatint plates by Robert Ladbrooke. £75

9. **Cotman, John Sell.** Specimens of Architectural Remains in various Counties in England, but principally in Norfolk, etched by John Sell Cotman, Esq. with descriptive notes by Dawson Turner, Esq. F.R.S. F.S.A. Etc. and architectural observations by Thomas Rickman, Esq. In Two Volumes. Volume I: I. Architectural Antiquities of Norfolk., II. Norman and Gothic Remains in Norfolk. Volume II: III. Castellated and Ecclesiastical Remains in Norfolk., IV. Architectural Remains in the Counties of York, Cambridge, Suffolk, Lincoln, Essex, and North Wales., V. Liber Studiorum., Folio Henry G. Bohn, 1838. HB.

In half morocco with a little wear and some soiling to the boards. TEG and with plain brown endpapers. The plates are in very good clean condition with just a few at the rear of volume two having some staining to the edges. 5 parts in 2 volumes as reissued by Bohn. Originally issued by Cotman himself pre-1820 the copper plates were purchased and published later by Bohn. £2000

10. **Cozens-Hardy, Basil. Kent, Ernest A.** The Mayors of Norwich 1403 to 1835 being Biographical Notes on the Mayors of the old Corporation, Large 8vo 188pp Jarrold and Sons, Limited, 1938. HB.

A fine copy which has the original blank paper wrapper. £57.50

11. **[Cromwell, Thomas Kitson],** Excursions in the County of Norfolk comprising a brief historical and topographical delineation of every town and village; together with descriptions of the residences of the nobility and gentry, remains of antiquity, and every other interesting object of curiosity forming a complete guide for the traveller and tourist illustrated with one hundred engravings including a map of the county. In two volumes, 8vo [2],iv,[4],199,[5]pp + [2],iv,[4],175,[3]pp Longman, Hurst, Rees, Orme and Brown; J. Greig; P. Youngman, 1818-1819. HB.

Large paper edition. In half calf with 2 raised bands and silver gilt capitalized title on morocco. New endpapers, AEG. The engravings are generally clean and bright and many are from John Sell Cotman drawings. £185

12. **Eade, Sir Peter.** Some Account of the Parish of St. Giles, Norwich, With Maps, Parish Lists, and Numerous Illustrations., 8vo xiv,503,[1]pp Jarrold & Sons, 1886. HB.

Ex Walsingham College Library in contemporary green cloth with gilt borders and title to the front. A sound copy, TEG and light spotting to the edges. With many illustrations and a fold out plan. £75

13. **Emerson, P[eter] H[enry].** Wild Life on a Tidal Water: The Adventures of A House-Boat and Her Crew, 4to xiii,[1],145,[1]pp Sampson, Low, Marston, Searle and Rivington, Limited, 1890. HB.

Respined (all Emersons books used a very poor quality leather for the spines which generally has disintegrated.) Limited to 500 copies (with perhaps only 300 produced) this is no. 7 with 30 very fine tissue guarded photo-etchings (photogravures) of around Breydon and the Port in Great Yarmouth. Illustrated books by Emerson are rare and sought after, especially by 'photographic breakers'. A poor copy of Life and Landscape recently fetched over £70,000 at auction. £2250

14. **Fitch, Robert.** Views of the Gates of Norwich, Made in the Years 1792-3, by the late John Ninham, with an Historical Introduction, extracts from the Corporation Records and Papers of the late John Kirkpatrick. [...], 4to [4],xxxv,[1],36pp Cundall, Miller, and Leavins, 1861. HB.

Finely recased in modern green buckram with title in gilt to the spine and with new endpapers. A little light foxing but largely very good clean condition. With 23 plates (22 as expected plus an inserted Heigham Gate). £100

15. **Harrod, Henry.** Gleanings among the Castles and Convents of Norfolk, 8vo x,[2],349,[3]pp Published by Subscription, 1857. HB.

Soundly bound in cloth with title label largely missing. Engraved bookplates of Philip Hamond and Vice Admiral R. M. Harbord-Hamond to the front pastedown and free. With plates and coloured plans plus index. Foxing to endpapers with text and plates largely clean. £57.50

16. **Hunter, Joseph.** The History and Topography of Ketteringham, in the County of Norfolk, the Seat of Sir J. P. Boileau, Baronet., 4to ix,[1],70pp Charles Muskett, 1851. HB.

In a fine modern green buckram binding with title to the spine; also with new endpapers. Clean inside with inserted engravings of the interior and exterior of Ketteringham Hall. Scarce. £95

17. **Kent, Nathaniel.** General view of the Agriculture of the County of Norfolk; with Observations For the Means of its Improvement. [...], xvi,236,[2]pp Crouse, Stevenson, and Matchett; George Nichol, 1796. HB.

A rebaked copy in full calf boards and a more modern speckled light brown spine with raised bands and title & author in gilt on green morocco. Very good clean internal condition with foxing to the plates (all 3 present) and county sketch. A nice tight copy. £125

18. **Knights, Mark.** The Highways and Byeways of Old Norwich. A descriptive ramble through Conisford, the New Burgh, Westwick, Northwic & Tokethorpe, Wymer & the Liberty of the Prior, & Down the Wensum. [...], Small 4to 120pp Jarrold and Sons, 1887. HB.

Copy 52 of a limited edition of 350. Rubbed cloth and marbled boards commensurate with the next item. Foxing to the edges (TEG) otherwise sound with 50 full page illustrations by Percy Stimpson. Tipped in near the rear is a 4 page ink initialled sheet (1 blank) with a poem 'To the River Yare.' from Norwich Angling Club 'With the Secretary's best wishes for the New Year. 1<sup>st</sup> January 1891'. £57.50

19. **Knights, Mark.** Peeps at the Past; or, Rambles Among Norfolk Antiquities., Small 4to [2],x,[2],184pp Jarrold and Sons, 1892. HB.

Copy 60 of a limited edition of 60. Rubbed cloth and marbled boards. Ex libris bookplate to the front pastedown. Foxing to endpapers and some of the earlier and latter pages. Soundly bound with TEG. Plates (most tissue guarded) by Pococke. £45

20. **Ladbroke, Robert.** Views of the Churches in Norfolk, illustrative of Blomefields History of that County, from original drawings, In Three Volumes, Oblong Large 8vo J. B Ladbroke, 1823. HB.

552 lithographs by Ladbroke bound into 3 fine volumes in black half morocco with black buckram boards. Raised bands and gilt title to the spines. Volume I: A-F, Volume II: G-R, Volume III: S-Y. The first volume includes an original title page from 1823. Ladbroke produced around 670 churches in total during the 1820s and 1830s. Sold with Ron Fiske's monograph published for the Ladbroke exhibition at the City Bookshop in 2012. £3500

21. **[Leach and Son].** Fen and Marshland Churches [Photographs], 4to [Leach and Son], [1867-69]. HB.

A single volume containing the photographic plates for the 3 part work 'The Fen and Marshland Churches'. With 47 tissue guarded sepia photos. Red half morocco with a little rubbing and corner knocks. Marbled endpapers and AEG. Epsom College Library stamps to all three page edges and small class mark to the spine. Ex libris bookplate of Bernard Wallis to the front pastedown and that of Edmund Seymour Daubeney to a blank free. A little light foxing and soiling but with the photographs in clean condition which stand alone without text as a record of 19<sup>th</sup> Century East Anglian Churches. £150

22. **Lindley, Percy [Editor].** Seaside and Countryside by the Great Eastern Railway, Oblong 24mo 63,[1]pp Great Eastern Railway Company, [c. 1920]. PB.

Wear to the overlap of the cover otherwise sound with fine colour plates and fold out map. £25

23. **Mason, R H.** Norfolk Photographically Illustrated, Folio 16pp Mason and Co., [1865]. HB.

In red half morocco with decorated raised bands and title in gilt to the spine and with marbled endpapers. Superbly rebound with first and last few photographs relaid and with two additional photographs not called for. Norfolk's first photographically illustrated book. Several of the houses featured no longer exist. £1250

24. **Maxwell, Donald.** Unknown Norfolk: Being a series of unmethodical Explorations of the County illustrated in line and colour by the Author, 8vo [2],xiii,[1],207,[1]pp Jone Lane The Bodley Head Limited, 1925. HB. £25

A little staining to the boards and with sunning to the spine. Minor foxing internally not affecting the plates, one of which is loose.

25. **Norwich Art Circle.** Catalogue of the First Exhibition held at the Society's Room, Old Bank of England Chambers, Queen Street. September, 1885. Along with the catalogues of the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> exhibition and the catalogues of the 28<sup>th</sup> to 35<sup>th</sup> exhibition. 4to Norwich Art Circle, 1885-1900. PB.

A very rare near run of these parts as issued. All in good to very good condition but for the front cover loose to part one and a tear to the rear cover of part two. £325

26. **Norwich Art Circle.** Catalogue of the Exhibition held at The Society's Room, Old Bank of England Chambers. Queen Street: The First exhibition to the fourteenth exhibition all bound together in one volume, 4to Norwich Art Circle, 1885-1890. HB.

With all lithographs and front covers bound in as published and in very good condition. In worn half morocco which has splits and loss to the bottom of the spine (1 inch). £195

27. **Norwich Round Table Committee.** "Snapdragon": The Norwich Hospitals Annual issues 1930 to 1935 bound together in one volume, Large 8vo A.E. Soman & Co., Ltd., 1930-35. HB.

The first six issues bound together in green half morocco with raised bands and title in gilt to the spine. Slightly rubbed. Postage stamps and royal photo stuck to the front marbled endpapers with the rear free endpaper having been removed. Contents in very good clean condition and includes numerous colour art plates by noted local artists. £50

28. **Peaton, Arthur.** [Rackham, Arthur [Illus.]]. Pictures of East Coast Health Resorts, 4to 172,xxxv,[3]pp Jarrold & Sons, [1901]. HB.

Slight rubbing, fading and soiling to the original red cloth with title in gilt on decorated front board. Fine inside. Illustrated by Arthur Rackham whose early work (generally for Jarrold) encompassed East Anglian guide books. He later became famous for his 'fantasy' illustrations particularly for children's illustrated books. £75

29. **Pigott, B A.** Flowers & Ferns of Cromer & Its Neighbourhood., 12mo 99,[3]pp Jarrold and Sons, [1885]. HB.

Slight soiling and tanning to the boards; very good inside. £35

30. **Preston Willins, Edward.** Quaint Old Norwich, Folio [18]pp Edw. Preston Willins, [1884]. HB.

Half morocco with marbled boards and title to front and spine. Slightly rubbed. TEG and marbled endpapers. Internally fine. Copy 418 of a limited edition of 500. £65

31. **Preston Willins, Edward.** Some of the Old Halls and Manor-Houses in the County of Norfolk, Folio [2],v,[5]pp Jarrold & Sons, 1890. HB.

A little scuffing to the original boards and wear to the corners otherwise near fine with just slight tanning to the edges of the plates. £85

32. **Rye, Walter.** Tourist's Guide to Norfolk with some preliminary remarks as to its natives, their names, superstitions, and peculiarities., 16mo [8],128,[8]pp Edward Stanford, 1879. HB.

Ink inscription dated 1879 to the title page and some pencil notes to the text. £15

33. **Stark, James** [Illus]. **Robberds, J W.** Scenery of the Rivers of Norfolk, comprising The Yare, The Waveney, and The Bure., Folio [138]pp John Stacy; Moon, Boys, and Graves; Jennings and Chaplin, 1834. HB.

A very good set with 36 plates including vignettes. Bound in slightly stained green cloth with gilt triple line borders and title on the front. AEG. Slight splitting to front and rear endpapers. £250

34. **Stone, Francis.** Picturesque Views of all the Bridges belonging to the County of Norfolk in a series of eighty-four print in lithography [...] in Four Parts, Oblong Small 4to Engelmann, Graf, Coindet & Co., 1830-31. HB.

Bound in brown buckram in the four original parts with covers as issued. Staining to some pages but with the majority of plates in clean condition. 84 plates as called for. £400

35. **Walpole, Horace.** The Letters of Horace Walpole, Earl of Orford: including numerous letters now first published from the original manuscripts. In publishers purple blind stamped cloth with spine fading and nicks. Corners slightly bumped. Plates with some foxing otherwise clean inside. Engraved bookplate to 5 volumes, suggested in pencil to be of the Vivian family, possibly the 2<sup>nd</sup> Baron. £85

36. **Ward, C S.** The Eastern Counties: Their watering places, Cathedral Cities, and other places of interest, together with the approaches from London, 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition Revised 16mo 4,[4],xvi,131,[1],64pp Dulau & Co., 1886. HB.

Slight soiling and rubbing to the red cloth. Cut to one of the tourist ticket price pages otherwise internally fine with large blue advertising section to the rear. £15

By road, or cliff, or sands, it is a short stroll to Trimmingham village, another quiet holiday haven, where the cliffs reach their highest, and the hills open up far views.

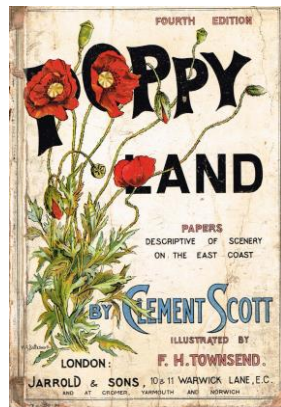
A fine walk past the "garden of sleep" brings one to Mundesley, a central position between its neighbouring villages of Trimmingham and Happisburgh. Quiet is the

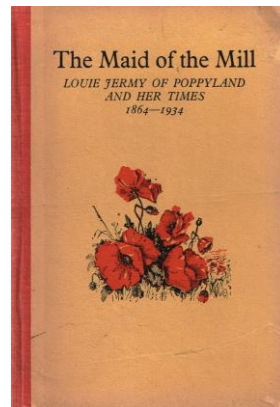

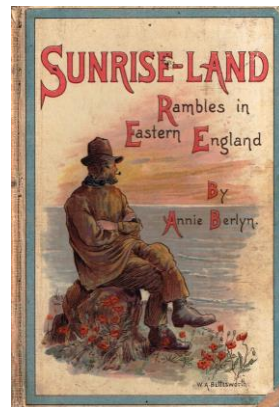
